Supervisor Kimball opened the meeting, and Sharon Mattison, Town Clerk led all those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. A moment of silence was observed for those serving in the military and in recognition of Marine Captain Philip J. Dykeman, a Brockport native who was killed while supporting Operation Iraqi Freedom.

OPEN FORUM

Mr. David Joseph, potential buyer of 3773 Lake Road, approached the Board with his interest in connecting to the existing sewer line that borders the property. The Board explained to Mr. Joseph that an extension to the sewer district would need to be created and that all expenses would be incurred by the property owner. Attorney, Dick Olson explained to Mr. Joseph that once he closes on the property a petition can then be signed and that his attorney should contact Mr. Olson so they can get the process started.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE

Bldg. Inspector, Larry Gurslin, advised the Board that he will be working with Attorney, Dick Olson to put together a proposed Property Maintenance Code for the Boards review. Councilperson Didas asked Bldg. Inspector Gurslin if he was aware of who mowed the lawn at 12 Larrigan Crossing. Mr. Gurslin stated a neighbor may have mowed the grass but he is not positive.

TOWN MOTTO

Councilperson Didas presented the Board with the idea of having a Town Motto. 59% of the towns and villages in Monroe County have one. He would like to involve community residents in selecting a Motto, possibly by way of a contest. Councilperson Didas will put together some ideas and get back to the Board in the future.
