Supervisor Kimball opened the meeting, and Sharon Mattison; Town Clerk led all those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. A moment of silence was observed for those serving in the military.

**OPEN FORUM**

Supervisor Kimball spoke on behalf of James Donahue, owner of Lots 15 and 16 also known as 7056 and 7066 Ridge Road located in Clarkridge Industrial Park. The Property was zoned Highway Commercial, however, when the proposed zoning map was updated, in error it was changed to residential zoning. The Board agreed to correct the zoning of Lots 15 and 16 to Industrial on the proposed map.

**CLARKSON MEADOWS PUMP STATION**

Supt. Goodwin advised the Board of the need to replace or repair the existing pump. After much discussion it was determined that it would be more feasible to replace the existing pump with a new 7½ hp pump. Supervisor Kimball stated that a Public Information meeting might be necessary to inform affected residents of the possible cost.

**INTERVIEWS FOR BUILDING INSPECTOR/CODE ENFORCEMENT/FIRE MARSHAL**

Interviews will be held Wednesday, December 3, 2008 at the Courthouse starting at 5:30 p.m. The Town Clerk will contact applicants and work with L. Gurslin to determine what certifications each applicant has.

**TRANSFER STATION FEES ON MONITORS**

It was decided by the Board not to implement an additional fee at this time but to continue to monitor the quantity dropped off at the transfer station. The Board feels that having the monitors recycled at Sunking is an environmentally friendly way of disposing of them.

**SPECIAL DISTRICTS**

Supt. Goodwin gave the Board an update on the Joseph Extension to the Clarkson Manor Sewer District advising them that we are waiting to hear from the Monroe County Health Department. Supt. Goodwin has spoken with resident, Daniel Knittle, 7631 Ridge Road regarding his failing septic system. Mr. Knittle has expressed an interest in hooking into the sewer district that services Mapleridge Coop as his residence is located just west of the park. Supt. Goodwin will speak with Attorney Olson to work out details. The State Comptrollers office informed Attorney, Richard Olson that the Clarkson Hamlin Water District #2 application has been filed with Monroe County, which is a sign that the application is progressing.

**HIGHWAY SUPT. REPORT**

Supt. Goodwin stated that the Town rents the recycling containers at the transfer station from Suburban Disposal at an approximate annual cost of \$5,000. It may be more feasible for the Town to purchase them at an approximate cost of \$6,500 each. Councilperson Didas stated that he would like to see a cost analysis before it can be determined whether to rent or purchase the containers. Goodwin informed the Board that fuel is \$2.02 per gallon before tax. Barden Homes has requested dedication of Wedgewood Drive. Supt. Goodwin would like to see the dedication completed at the December 9, 2008 Town Board meeting, he will have JP Schepp, Chatfield Engineering complete all necessary work.
