**Town of Clarkson Veteran's Memorial Park**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Clarkson is constructing a Veteran's Park on the area of a former brownfield AT 8264 Ridge Road in the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board has determined that the project is an **unlisted action** pursuant to SEQRA regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the board has reviewed the Short Environment Assessment Form on file in the Town Office; and

**WHEREAS**, on this date, February 22, 2011, at a public meeting meeting, the Town Board conducted the required SEQRA review process by reviewing said Short Environment Assessment Form

1. Based on its review of all of the evidence submitted and reviewed, and based upon the Town Board's deliberations and its review of the short Environmental Assessment Form for the proposed project, it is hereby determined that the proposed project will not have a significant impact on the environment and that a negative declaration is hereby issued.

2. This notice of this determination of non-significance shall be filed as required by SEQRA.
