MOTION REQUESTING NYSDOT SPEED LIMIT STUDY; DRAKE ROAD

HIGHWAY SUPT. REPORTS

Superintendent Viscardi reported that highway staff has been extremely busy. Recent work has included oil & stone on Lawton Road, Lawrence Road, and County Line Road; four days of work at the Monroe County Fair with the Towns of Sweden and Hamlin; and parking lot and sidewalk work at the Hilton schools, also with the Towns of Sweden and Hamlin.

Councilperson Didas questioned when the canopy would be removed at the College Service Center. Attorney Olson will investigate the criteria with respect to removing pumps after tanks and report back to the Board.

Councilperson Filipowicz expressed concern about people driving on the grass while using the lodges. A “*No Parking on the Grass*” rule will be incorporated into the rental application forms indicating that repair of any damage will be charged to the users.

Supervisor Kimball mentioned the need to re-negotiate details regarding field use, lining of the fields, and port-a-john rentals with the Brockport Blizzard organization for next year.
