

## 12/2/2024 Clarkson Historic Commission Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM

  - Al Hoy submitted yearly report to New York State Office of Historic Preservation
- New Business
  - Discussion of properties potentially to locally designate
  - 1987 survey laid out other properties to be considered
  - Leanna Hale commission member and town historian identified several properties that were school houses

- Prior property, a church at 3723 Sweden Walker Road was discussed at prior meeting see minutes dated 2/5/24 as potential designation and preservation site

- Chairperson Hoy recommends researching perhaps 1-3 properties for commission to begin with
- L. Hale suggests Garland area properties of 3723 Sweden Walker Rd. & 7528 West Ridge Road-but board acknowledges they are unsure of this address
  - Property address references cobblestone garage of historical significance that was a site of Red Cross production house to provide bandages during World War I home production
  - The barn which remains standing may be addressed to 7538 West Ridge Road
  - Likely the property was cited for further investigation
- Board analyzed potential of calling for public hearing of these two properties for next meeting January 6<sup>th</sup> 2025 to locally designate

- M. Hennard and A. Hoy both acknowledge research needs to be done to see if either property is in line with goals of historic commission to designate
- Town Board liaison N. D'Amuro acknowledges it is possible to use the next month to investigate properties, final investigation together at next meeting on January 6<sup>th</sup>, and calling for the public hearing for February
- Members agree this might be more effective plan to ensure the commission is in line with its legislative goals and is not rushing into its first designation
